Subscriptions

Fees: April 1st – 31st March

ADULTS: £90

FAMILY: (2 ADULTS + CHILDREN U18 or in Full Time Education) £195

Junior/Student (in full time education): £ 50

Over 65s: £70

Fees are non-refundable

Half rate applies from 1st **September**

Guest fees: (with a member) £2.50 per player

ALL PLAYERS PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK

New Members: All prospective members must apply via ClubSpark :

Prospective adult members can play 3 times after which they may be invited to join the Club.

Dress: all players are expected to wear suitable tennis attire and footwear.

Times of Play: Adults Club Night Friday 5pm til dusk.

Adults Club Morning Sunday 10am – 12noon

Juniors by invitation only.

Members can play at any other time when the courts are not being used for matches or coaching, both of which take priority. The duration of the session should be restricted to 1 hour if others are waiting.

Club Play: All players to mix in at all times. If there are players waiting please restrict the number of games to 5.

Adult coaching: This is available on a Thursday Evening at the Rusty Racquets or Friday afternoon Refresher course or privately with Sheetal Pandya, Club Coach (mobile: 07931 357661)

Adult Teams: The Club has 4 Men's Teams; 2 Mixed teams; 2 Ladies and 1 Seniors (over 55s) who play in the Halstead and District Tennis League. See fixture list for details of times of matches.

Juniors: Group coaching is held on Saturday mornings with home & away matches on Saturday afternoons. Individual coaching is also available - contact Sheetal: 07931 357661

Club Affiliation: The Club is affiliated to the LTA. All members qualify for free British Tennis Membership but must register through the LTA web site.

All 'Opted in' BTM members are eligible to enter the draw for the Club's allocation of Wimbledon tickets for 2018.
